

# Cheery Robins

Use knitting needles size 9 (3.25mm) and double knitting wool throughout

NB. In the first 6 rows, light brown wool needs to be worked behind red wool (as in Fair Isle knitting) make sure light brown and red wool are twisted together at joins to prevent holes.



Cast on 20 sts in light brown (lb).

Row 1            K7 lb, K6 red, K7 lb

Row 2            P7 lb, P6 red, P7 lb

Row 3            K7 lb, K6 red, K7 lb

Row 4            P7 lb, P6 red, P7 lb

Row 5            K8 lb, 4 red, 8 lb

Row 6            K8 lb, 4 red, 8 lb

Change to mid brown.

Row 7            K

Row 8            P

Row 9            (K1, m1)            repeat to end            (30 sts)

Row 10           P

Row 11           K2 tog            repeat to end            (15 sts)

Row 12           P

Row 13           K2 tog to last st, K1            (8 sts)

Break off yarn and with a needle thread through remaining stitches, pull tight and finish off tightly leaving a loop of wool on right side for hanging.

Stick on googly eyes and felt beak as shown.
